SAMPLE LANGUAGE

If you would like to leave a general bequest:

General bequests are legacies left to causes that come from the general value of the estate, and are made by designating a specific dollar amount, a particular asset, or a fixed percentage of your estate to the cause of your choice.

If you want to leave a donation in the event that the party you originally intended the gift for predeceases you (contingent beneficiary):

If you want to leave parts of your estate to others and the remainder to charity (residuary legatee):

If you want to leave assets to an individual (such as a partner or child) for use during their lifetime, but direct it to CLCV/ CLCVEF upon his or her death:
